Buck A Jeans Day: Just a quick reminder on Buck A Jeans Day: Students need to bring their dollar into class to give to the teacher if they plan to wear jeans. **Jeans must be clean and in good condition with no holes. 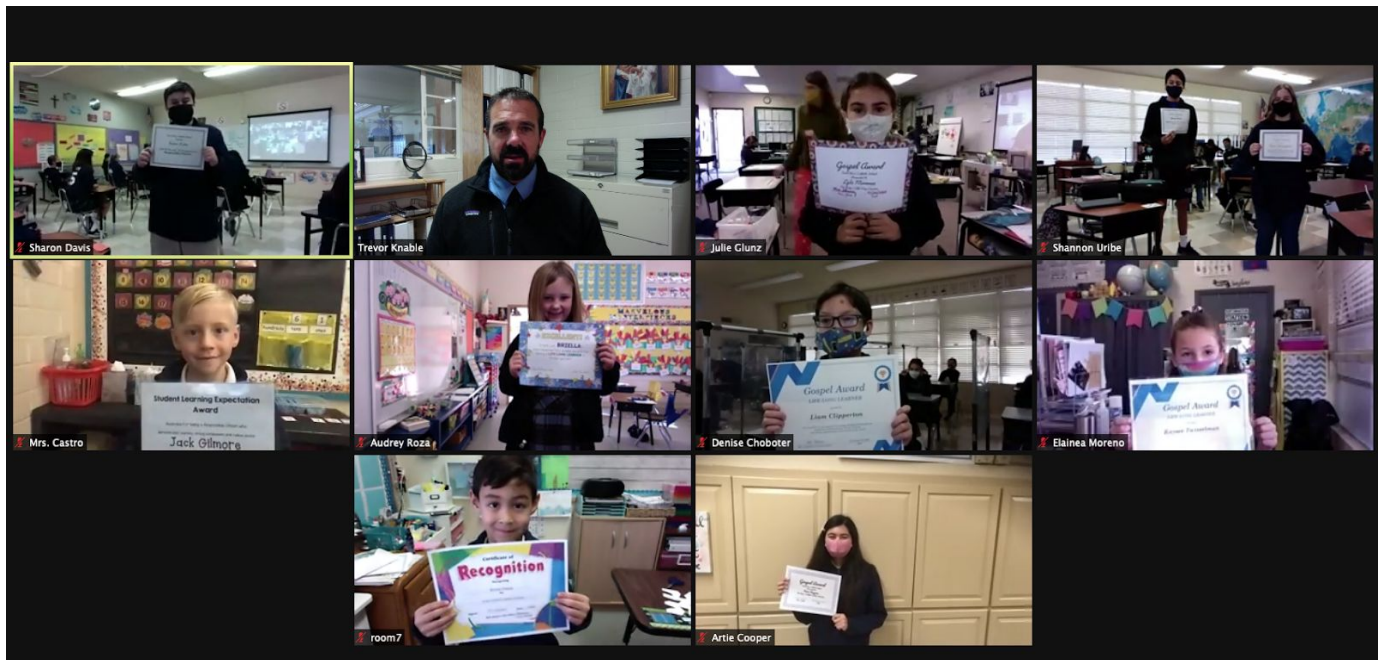
