Message From the Principal

I pray that everyone had a safe, enjoyable, and relaxing Christmas and vacation and that their new year is off to a great start. Hopefully, you could spend quality time with friends and family and enter the new year with an open mind and a clean slate, as referenced in the prayer for the month. We have come to the midpoint of the 2022 - 2023 academic year. With the beginning of the 3rd quarter last week, it is that time for parents to begin making decisions on registration for the 2023 - 2024 school year.

My staff and I are honored that you have placed your children's education and safety in the hands of the St. Rose Catholic School staff. As of this writing, half of our classes are at their maximum capacity, with waitlists for the 2023 - 2024 school year. **Due to demand and budgeting purposes, families of current students planning to enroll for the upcoming school year must register during the "Returning" student enrollment period, as I cannot guarantee a spot after the "returning" enrollment period ends.** Additionally, early

enrollment allows us to budget for the upcoming school year properly. **Please see below for information on registration, dates, timelines, and 2023 - 2024 Tuition and Fees:**

- **Registration Information:** Registration for the 2023 - 2024 school year will continue to be done electronically through your FACTS Family Portal. **An email from Michelle Machado will be sent out to each family with a link to registration once it is open. Please remember that you must be current on tuition and your children current on their immunization status to receive this link.** All currently enrolled students are guaranteed a spot for the 2023 - 2024 school year, provided they are registered during the "Returning St. Rose Catholic Student" enrollment period."
- **Dates and Timeline:** Registration is broken down into tiers for both Preschool registration and K - 8th-grade registration:
 - **Preschool Registration: \$200.00 per student**
 - Returning preschool students: February 6 - 10 (current preschool students guaranteed a spot)
 - Siblings of currently enrolled Pre - K through 8th-grade students: February 13 - 17
 - New Family Registration: March 6 - 17 (non-current students and families)
 - **K - 8th Grade Registration:** Registration rates of \$350.00 apply to returning families through March 3 and become \$400.00 on March 4, 2023.
 - Returning currently enrolled Pre - K through 7th-grade students: February 13 - 24 (current students guaranteed a spot)
 - Siblings of returning students: February 27 - March 3 (brothers and sisters of current students who are not currently enrolled)
 - New Family Registration: March 6 - 17 (non-current families)
- **Tuition and Fees: Tuition for the upcoming school year will jump slightly with an increase of 4%. For grades K - 8, this tuition increase amounts to \$253.00 (Parishioner rate) and \$269.00 (Non-Parishioner rate).** Another way of looking at this tuition increase is that it increases either **\$1.40 or \$1.49 per day/student**, based on your child(ren)'s rate. For preschool students, this 4% increase equates to roughly \$1.60 per day. This 4% increase comprises a 1% bump over the five-year average of 3% per year. The bulk of this 4% increase goes directly to staff salaries and benefits, our largest expense. I feel strongly that I need to compensate my staff, who truly take care of your children each day and are the foundation of the St. Rose Catholic School.
- **Financial Assistance:** Financial assistance is available to students in grades K - 8 on a limited basis. Most monies allocated for assistance come from donations and our Scholarship Drive during our St. Rose Catholic School Auction event. Financial aid is given on a need-only basis and can be applied through FACTS Management Company, linked to our website under [Tuition Assistance](#). **The application window is from February 6 - March 17.** The process is as follows:
 - Family applies through a third party, FACTS Management Company.
 - After reviewing the application and required documents (you will need to utilize your most recent tax information), FACTS will recommend that the applicant at St.

Rose Catholic School tuition assistance be awarded. (Assistance is based upon tuition only, not associated fees).

- After reviewing FACTS recommendations and confirming monies received through the Scholarship Drive and scholarship donations, we will send out letters of tuition awards in mid-April.

According to data from our 2021 - 2022 Parent Satisfaction Survey, 106 of 111 respondents stated "Yes" to the question, "Do you feel that the education received at St. Rose Catholic School is worth the tuition cost?"

27th Annual St. Rose Catholic School Auction Event: As stated before the Christmas break, we are planning a revamped and reimagined auction event! Staffing Updates: I have begun the staff planning process for the 2023 - 2024 school year.

- **Spanish:** Unfortunately, we could not secure a Spanish teacher for the 2022 - 2023 school year; however, I am committed to hiring one for the upcoming school year. If you know of anyone who may be interested and qualified for this position, please pass along this Edjoin [link](#) to find out more information or apply.
- **Classroom Teacher's Assistant/Library:** After many years at St. Rose, Ms. Swensson will be retiring. I cannot stress how much time, effort, dedication, and love Ms. Swensson has poured into St. Rose Catholic School and its students since Ms. Swensson began here in 1995. If you (this is a great job for a parent looking to work the same hours that their children are in school) or someone you know may be interested in this position, please pass along this Edjoin [link](#) to find out more information or apply. This is a great job for an individual who is interested in working approximately the same hours that their children are in school.
- **Middle School Math and Social Studies:** Effective immediately, I am searching for a middle school math and/or social studies teacher for the remainder of this school year and the following school years. It is unusual to have a position open in the middle of a school year, however, circumstances have dictated this. If you know of anyone who may be interested and qualified for this position, please pass along this Edjoin [link](#) (long-term substitute) or this Edjoin [link](#) (teaching position 2023 - 2024) to find out more information or apply.

Extended Care Sign Up: Thank you to those using the Sign Up Genius [link](#) on our website to pre-register your children for extended care. It has been working well with most students pre-registered so that we don't go over a safe number of students daily. It worked so well that

some have been signing children up, and we then have several "no-shows" holding up others from registering and holding spots that are not being used. **Please remove your children's names by noon on the day they are signed up so that space opens up and we are not looking for a child.** Beginning February 1, 2023, a \$25.00 "no show" fee will be added to your FACTS account for every third "no show" at extended care. Families can easily avoid this fee by removing their children's names from the list before noon if they are not attending extended care.

Book Fair: We are excited to host our first **Literati Book Fair held from Jan. 30 - Feb. 3** during Catholic Schools Week. Come visit and shop Monday-Thursday from 2-3:30 (Friday 10:30-12:30) in the school library. Be sure to invite grandparents and special friends on Friday. You may also shop at our online store by searching for our school at efairs.literati.com. Please share with family and friends. Thank you for supporting our school.
