

As Volunteer Service Hour Coordinator, Michelle will:

- Advertise volunteering opportunities
- Help parents get involved and report their service hours to meet 20 hour requirement
- Answer questions regarding service hours
- <u>Service Hour forms</u> available on school website
- Service hour fulfillment offerings

Safe Environment Requirements for Volunteers per The Diocese of Monterey:

To <u>volunteer on campus</u> while in presence of students (classroom helper, field trip chaperone, working with students on projects in or outside of classroom, running booths at school events, etc.) you will need the following:

- Live Scan fingerprinting
- Current negative T.B. test (good for 4 years)
- VIRTUS Online Training courses

To volunteer as a <u>driver</u>:

- Volunteer on campus requirements AND
- Copy of current drivers license and auto insurance policy (100,000/300,000 minimum) with term length
- Diocesan Driver form
- Smart Driver Online training

VIRTUS:

Training Required:

- Diocese of Monterey Online Registration Instructions
- Required to take every three years
- Most due for renewal this year

Volunteering Protocol

*Note: Masking required indoors 2021 - 2022 school year per CDPH guidelines.

Volunteering on school grounds:

- First stop: School office for volunteer badge and sign in
- Business: Proceed to your volunteer classroom or position
- After volunteering: Stop by school office to return volunteer badge and sign out

Working in the classroom:

- Meet teacher's specific requirements
- Respect privacy of individual students and their families
- Maintain classroom expectations and rules.
 If discipline consequences are necessary,
 report issue to classroom teacher
- Please refrain from cell phone usage/step outside if necessary
- Confidentiality

Volunteering Protocol (con't.)

Working with food:

- Clean hands and use serving gloves
- Only volunteer if you are in good health
- If you are sick or feeling unwell, please remain at home

Working on the school playground or school functions:

- Discipline: beyond simple issues, report to teacher
- Injury: if on playground, escort to office, if at event, report to event director/school employee
- NO CELL PHONE USAGE

Volunteering Protocol (con't.)

Field trip/sports driver or chaperone:

- Functional seat belt for each individual
- Driver must carry copies of permission slip for all students in vehicle
- Cell phone/electronic device usage is PROHIBITED while driving

Emergency/Drill:

- Stay with students in case of emergency and complete drill in case of drill
- Emergency first aid and emergency kits

Campus Courtesy:

- Respect staff lounge and school office
- Come into office if you need something from classroom or drop off items
- Use staff/volunteer restrooms...DO NOT use student restrooms
