Message From the Principal: 2026 - 2027 Registration Information

I am incredibly blessed and humbled to serve as an administrator at St. Rose Catholic School. While every school year brings its own unique experiences, what remains constant is the joy and excitement I see on the faces of our students each day. My staff and I are honored that you have chosen St. Rose Catholic School for your children's education and safety. Your role in our school community is invaluable, and we are deeply grateful for your trust and support. As we approach the midpoint of another successful academic year and begin planning for the 2026 – 2027 school year, we look forward to continuing this journey with you.

Registration for currently enrolled students will begin in early February. All students who are currently enrolled are **guaranteed a spot for the upcoming school year** provided they register during the *Returning St. Rose Catholic School Student* enrollment period. This early registration window is essential, as it allows us to responsibly plan and budget for the coming year. Registration will take place electronically through your **FACTS Family Portal** (you will receive a notification from FACTS once registration opens). Please note that to receive the registration link, families must be current on tuition payments and student immunizations.

Registration is divided into two categories: **Preschool** and **K – 8**.

Preschool Registration Fee: \$225.00 per student

- Returning Preschool Students: February 2 – 6 (guaranteed placement)
- Siblings of currently enrolled Pre - K – 8 students: February 9 – 13
- New Family Registration: March 2 – 13

K – 8 Registration Fee:

- \$375.00 for returning families through March 1
- \$425.00 beginning March 2, 2026

K – 8 Registration Windows:

- Returning Pre-K – 7 students: February 9 – 20 (guaranteed placement)
- Siblings of returning students (not currently enrolled): February 23 – 27
- New Family Registration: March 2 – 13

Balancing affordability for families with our commitment to academic excellence and fair compensation for our faculty and staff is an ongoing challenge. I appreciate the financial sacrifices you make to provide your children with a faith - based education. After careful consideration and discernment, the School Advisory Committee and I have approved a **modest 5% tuition increase** for the 2026 – 2027 school year:

- **K – 8 Parishioner Tuition:** Annual increase of \$362.00
- **K – 8 Non-Parishioner Tuition:** Annual increase of \$385.00

Pre - K tuition will also increase by 5%, with exact amounts dependent upon half - day or full - day attendance and the number of days per week.

Fees for Pre - K – 8 (Technology, Consumables, Building & Grounds) will remain unchanged. The **yearbook fee (\$25.00)** has been incorporated into the registration fee, and the **Centegix Crisis Alert License** will be assessed as a **per - family fee of \$65.00**.

These adjustments allow us to continue supporting and retaining our dedicated teachers and staff while keeping pace with inflation. Our educators earn approximately 75 – 80% of local public school salaries and do not receive comparable retirement benefits, yet they choose to serve at St. Rose Catholic School for the benefit of **your children**. Thank you for recognizing and supporting their commitment.

Tuition assistance is available on a limited basis for students in grades K – 8. A portion of the aid is funded through donations and our annual Auction Scholarship Drive, with the rest made up as a budgeted line item. Over the past two years, nearly **\$120,000.00** has been awarded to families in need. The **tuition assistance application window will run February 2 – March 13**. Applications submitted during this window receive priority consideration.

The process includes:

- Submission through FACTS Management Company
- Review using the family's most recent tax information
- FACTS provides a recommended tuition assistance amount (tuition only)
- Tuition award letters are sent in mid - April after funds are finalized

Please do not hesitate to contact me directly if financial hardship may impact your child's ability to attend St. Rose Catholic School. I am committed to working with families whenever possible. To apply for tuition assistance, please click [here](#).

I know that families have choices when it comes to education, and I am deeply grateful that you have entrusted us with your children. I am equally grateful for the faculty and staff who have chosen to serve this community. We work diligently to keep tuition as affordable as possible, and **I am encouraged that 90.91% of families, according to the 2024 – 2025 Parent Feedback Survey, feel that the education their children receive is worth the cost.** Thank you for your continued partnership and support. I look forward to another wonderful year working together in the education and formation of your children.
