# **Message From the Principal**

Believe it or not, we are two-thirds of the way through the school year, and I'm working on staffing, amongst other plans for next year. I understand that around registration time, there are often questions about what teachers and staff are or are not returning. As it stands right now, we anticipate very little turnover, which is beneficial to everyone, from the children to the families to the faculty and staff.

The one certainty is that I will be hiring for the <u>first-grade position</u> for the 2025 - 2026 school year and that after many years as a student and then a preschool teacher, Ms. Emily **Ezzo will be moving on.** While I will be hiring for the first-grade position, it is too early to

determine if we will hire a new preschool staff member or reallocate hours amongst our current staff. This potential for growth and change is exciting, and I anticipate some minor juggling of schedules and positions as I allocate hours for the upcoming school year.

With registration for returning students and siblings of current students wrapping up on February 28, we will be opening registration to those children and families who are not currently involved with the school on March 3, 2025. The early deadline is to ensure we can plan for the upcoming school year effectively. That said, I anticipate that kindergarten and fourth grade will be full for next year. If you are a current family member and have not yet registered for either of those classes, I can no longer guarantee a spot for your child after tomorrow.

Returning to this school year, I'd like to welcome families who would like to attend our Lenten Mass on WednesdayI'darch 19. Bishop Danny has set the day aside to host Mass at St. Rose Catholic School with our students and families. Please remember to enter the church through the side door closest to the school. It is always nice to have our Bishop on campus to celebrate Mass with us and spend some time on campus. We would love to have you attend the Mass as well!
