Message From the Principal: Looking Ahead to 2026 - 2027 School Year

Planning for the 2026–2027 school year is upon us. **Our registration season begins the first week of February, and early registration ends on March 1, 2026.** For specific registration dates and times, please refer back to my [January Principal's Newsletter](#).

After receiving the Diocese of Monterey Master Calendar, I have been able to confirm the start and end dates for the upcoming school year, as well as days off, minimum days, and vacation periods. We have received a few emails and phone calls regarding difficulty accessing the school calendar on the website. For safety reasons, the calendar was removed from public access. As a reminder, families can now view it through their FACTS Family Portal or link it directly to their personal calendar using the instructions that were shared in early January. If you are still experiencing difficulty accessing the calendar or cannot locate the instructions, please reach out to Paula for assistance.

This time of year is also when I begin posting known job openings for the next school year and working through the annual process of faculty and staff assignments. As with any school,

there is some level of turnover each year. Now that I have received most faculty and staff letters of intent for the upcoming school year, I can begin planning staffing needs and posting available positions later this month. The transition from the 2025–2026 school year to the 2026–2027 school year will be no different. I will follow up later in February to communicate any known staffing changes at that time.

2026 St. Rose Catholic School Spelling Bee: Our sixth annual Spelling Bee was a great success! We had numerous participants, and it was wonderful to see the strong sportsmanship and encouragement displayed throughout the event. Hats off to our school champion, **Nora Glunz**, for an outstanding performance! Ms. Davis summed up the event perfectly:

On Thursday, January 22, we held the 6th annual St. Rose Spelling Bee. Earlier in the week, each class held class challenges to determine their finalists for the school bees. The lower school held its final rounds at 9am and the top five spellers advanced to the upper school bee, which started at 10:45. The school wide competition began with twenty-five students ranging from fourth to eighth grade. After many tense rounds, Melissa Yanez(8), Juline Hanna(6), and Nora Glunz(6) emerged as the top three finalists. Melissa finished in third place, and Juline placed second. On the twelfth round, Nora Glunz emerged as our school champion with the winning word: lacrosse, and the final word for champion: lye. The school participates in the Scripts National Spelling Bee competition, so Nora will advance to the regional level, which is held in early February.
