Principal's Message

It has been wonderful hearing the children's voices on the playground and throughout the campus during these first two weeks of school. Familiar faces have returned and reconnected with friends, while new students have been welcomed and embraced by their classmates. I remain deeply grateful to the families who entrust my staff and me with their children's academic growth, social-emotional development, and safety.

My goal is to be at the front of the school during morning drop-off as often as possible. To help keep our children safe, I ask that all families use the two designated crosswalks in a parking lot. Building this habit early is an important life skill. Additionally, I encourage everyone—no matter how rushed we may feel—to drive slowly, remain aware of traffic flow, and stay attentive to your surroundings. Together, we can ensure a safe environment for all.

On the topic of safety, please remember that anyone wishing to volunteer on campus or with students must first be cleared (DOJ fingerprinting, TB negative test, Virtus training, etc.). Since fingerprinting, in particular, can take a couple of weeks, I encourage you to start the process as soon as possible. Too often, a parent wants to step in to help with a field trip or event on short notice, but without clearance, it isn't possible. If you plan to volunteer at all this year or during your child's education at St. Rose Catholic School, please see Paula at the front desk soon to get the process underway.

New Items/Upcoming Events

Key Cards / Gate Access: Please remember to carry your school gate card with you at all times. At times when you ring in, office staff may be assisting others, answering phones, tending to an injured student, or on their break. Carrying your card helps keep our campus secure and ensures smooth entry. If your family would like an additional gate card, you may purchase one at the office. We have also recently added **key fobs** that attach to your keychain for convenience. These are available in the office for **\$10 each**.

Did You Know?

You may have noticed that **STAR Testing** is on the calendar for mid-September. So, what is STAR Testing? Simply put, it is the standardized assessment tool used by many private and parochial schools to measure student proficiency and growth in **reading**, **math**, **and early literacy**. In the Diocese of Monterey, STAR assessments are administered **three times a year** (Fall, Winter, and Spring). They are **computer-adaptive and comprehensive**, meaning they adjust to each child's ability level while providing detailed insight into learning progress.

Parents will receive access to their child's results for:

- Fall testing → shared at Fall Conferences
- Winter testing → shared at Spring Conferences

This process allows teachers and parents to partner together in supporting each child's academic growth.
